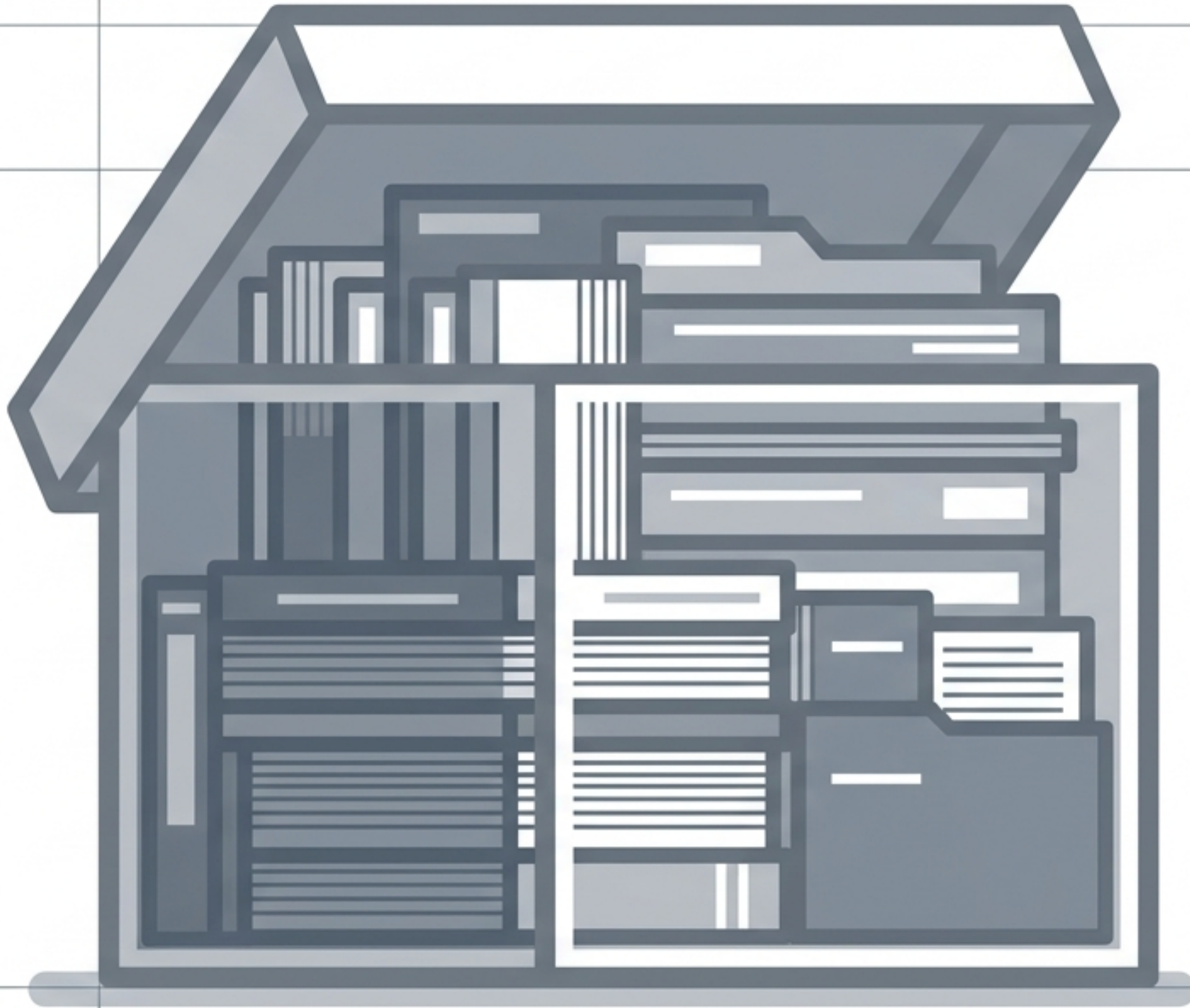

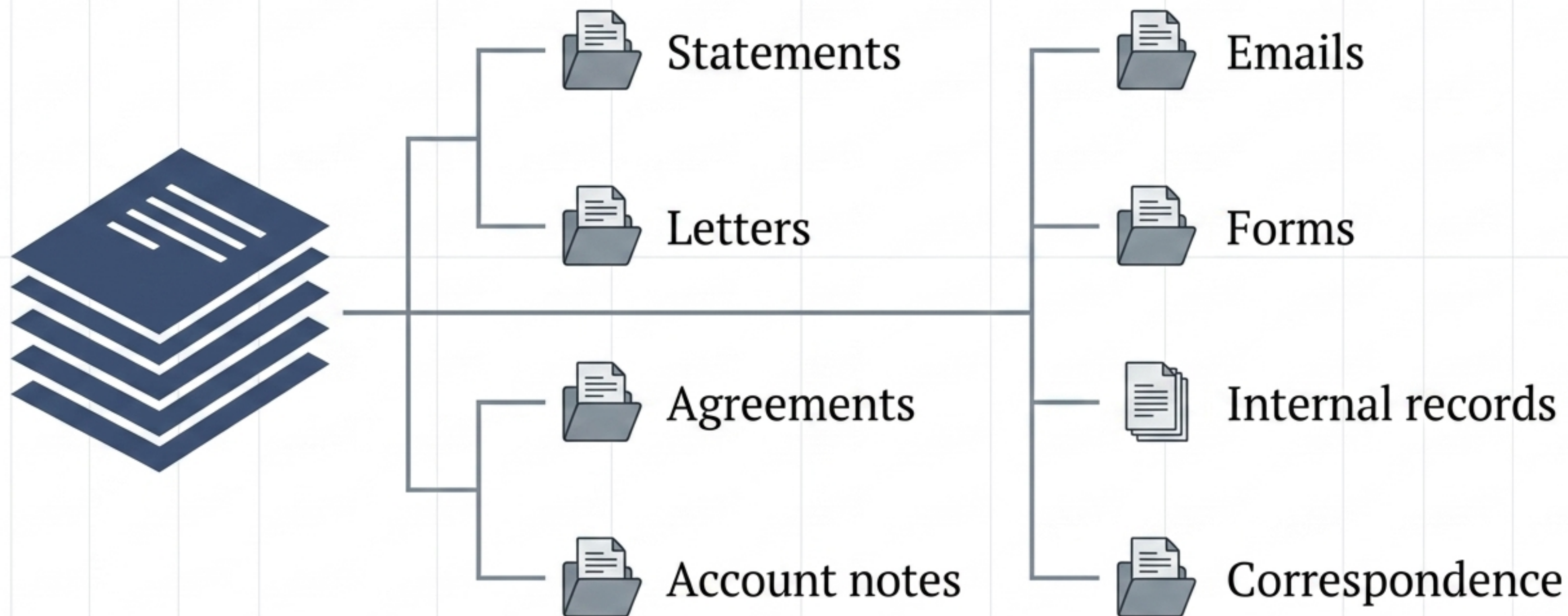
A practical guide to bringing borrower records into order



The problem

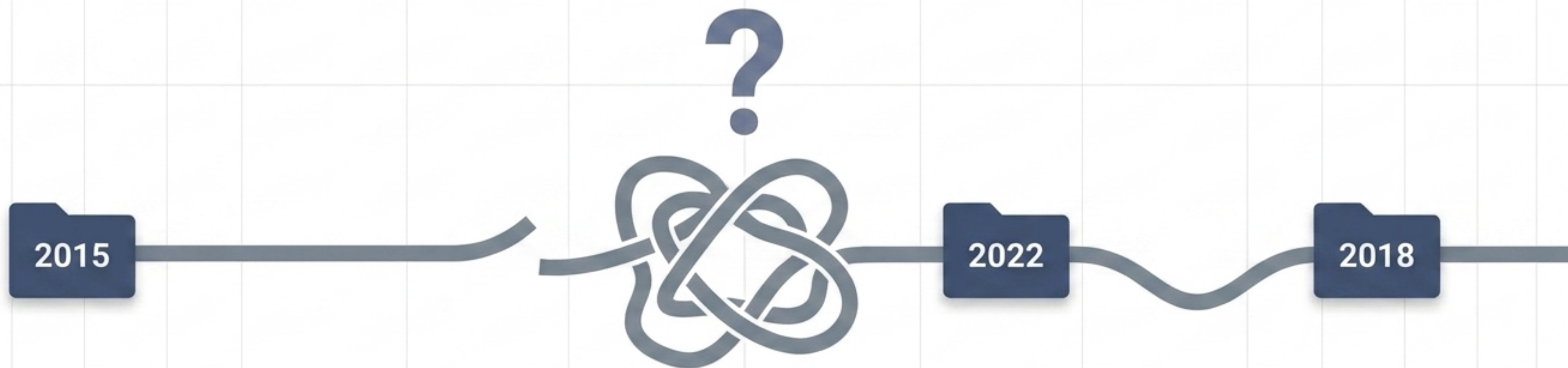
Requesting information may produce hundreds or thousands of pages. Receiving records is only the first step.

may struggle to help.

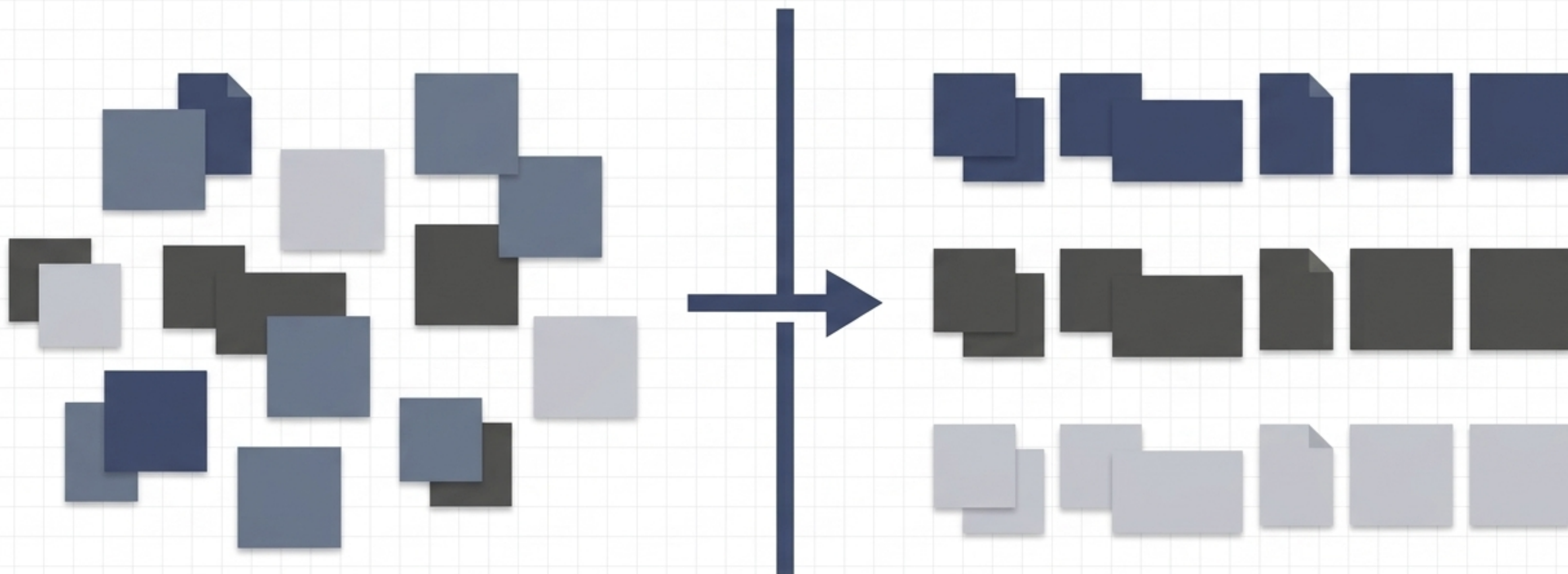

Missing or unclear items.

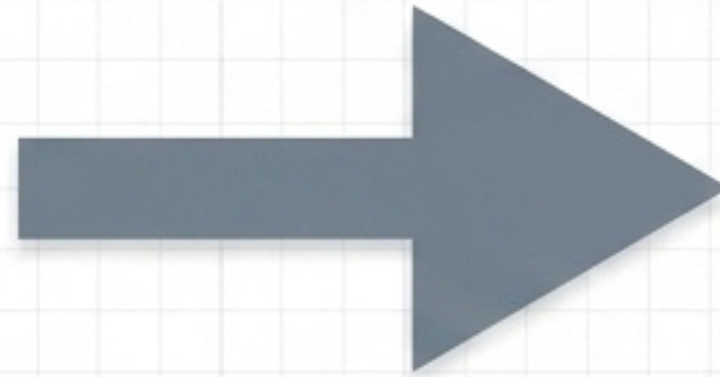
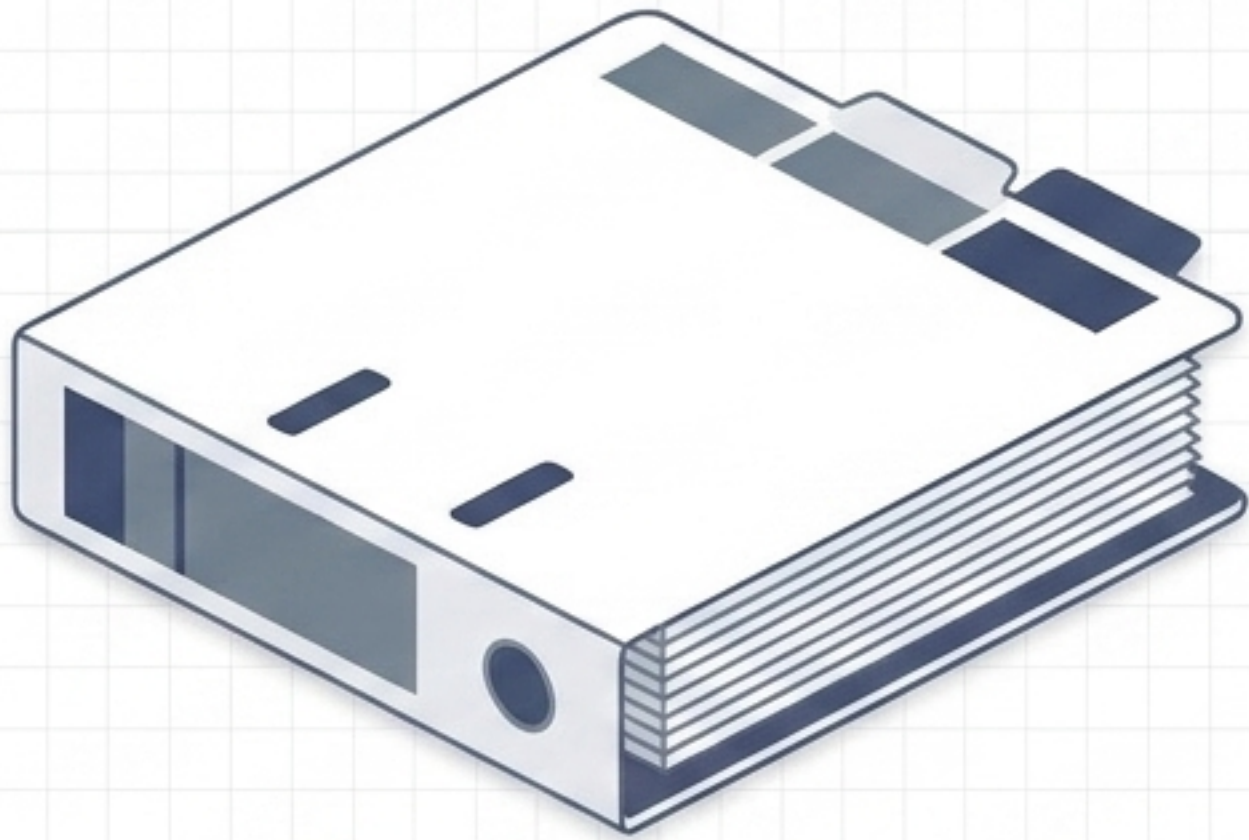

It does not confirm lender fault, decide claims, or guarantee outcomes.

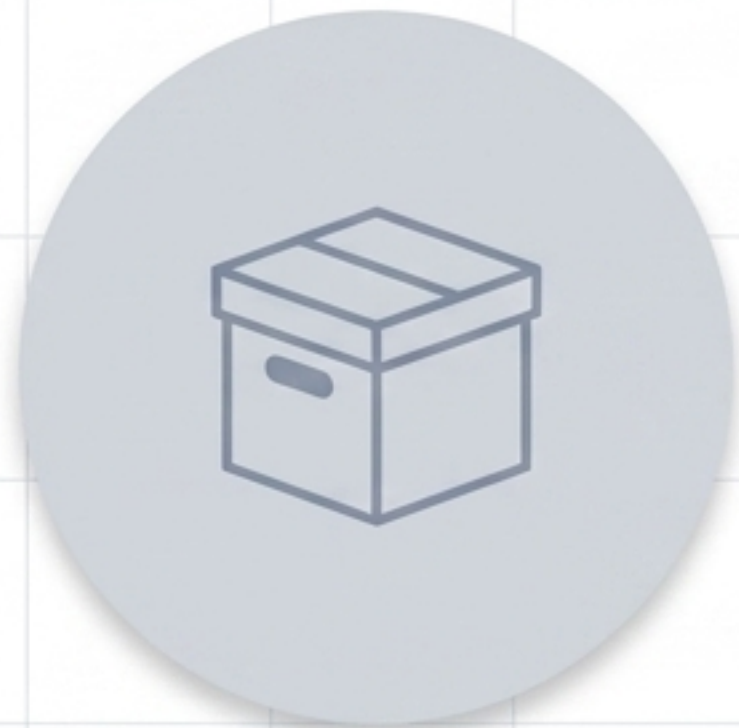


It does not replace qualified professionals.



Closing message

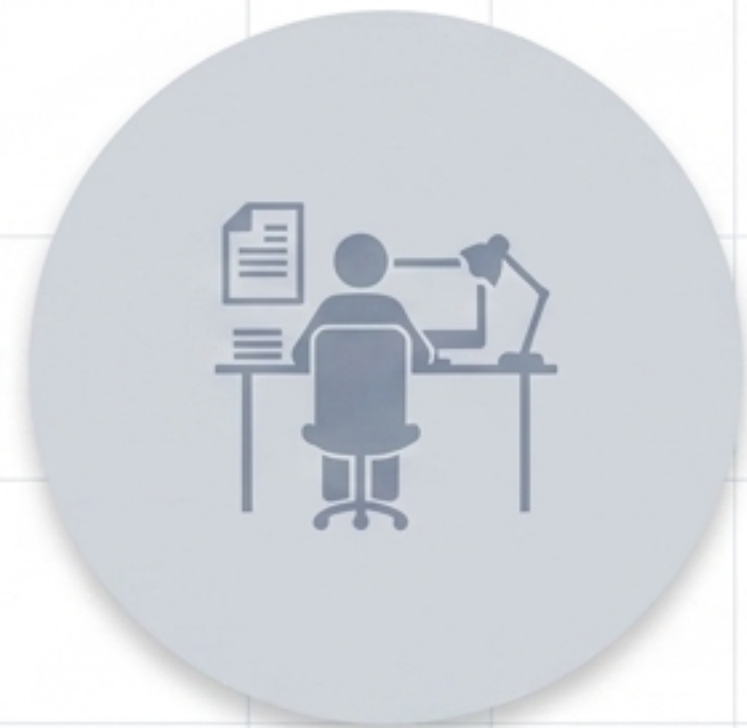
Start with order. Then review properly. If a large document pack has arrived and you are unsure where to begin, the first step is to bring the material into order.
